## Summary

- 1. We can reject the hypothesis that the deglaciations are unrelated to obliquity.
- 2. We cannot reject the hypothesis that the deglaciations are triggered
- by obliquity. We cannot reject the hypothesis that the deglaciations are unrelated to either precession or eccentricity.
- 4. We can reject the hypothesis that the deglaciations are triggered by
- eccentricity.
- 5. Precession is fuzzy and is different in early and late Pleistocene.

## Conclusion

Deglaciation are triggered by obliquity, not by either precession or eccentricity
